



Anticipated Growth in California Jobs that Require a Master's Degree from 2016 to 2027





The Mission of the CSU


- Undergraduate and graduate instruction up through the master's degree


CSU Degrees Earned 2017-2018



Master of Library and Information Science

San José State University

- Fully online master's program
- Largest producer of library science degree holders in the nation
- One of the most cost-effective library science programs



Future Faculty Programs

California Pre-Doctoral Program

- Started in 1989
- Designed to increase the pool of potential CSU faculty
- 2018-19 awarded funds to 75 CSU students
- In the past 5 years, 40% of participants have entered fully-funded Ph.D. programs



Future Faculty Programs

Chancellor's Doctoral Incentive Program

- Largest program of its kind
- Designed to increase the pool of potential CSU faculty
- More than 60% of CDIP scholars who completed their doctorates are now CSU faculty
