Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the March 20, 2012 meeting were approved as submitted.

Action Items

The Committee adopted the California State University's initial bargaining proposals for successor contract bargaining with The Stationary Engineers and Trades in Bargaining Unit 10 at the Maritime Academy represented by the International Union of Operating Engineers (IUOE); and the Head Start Employees in Bargaining Unit 12 at San Francisco State represented by the California State Employees Union (CSUEU). Vice Chancellor Gail Brooks presented the items.

Public Speakers

CSUEU Officers Pat Gantt, Russell Kilday-Hicks, Tessy Reese and John Orr addressed the Committee about the challenges, such as the lack of salary progression, facing the CSUEU bargaining unit. They all pledged to work with the CSU to attempt to resolve these difficult issues ahead. Dr. Andy Merrifield, the Chair of the CFA's bargaining team then discussed the breakdown in the faculty bargaining and urged the CSU to negotiate a fair and balanced contract.
