COAST awards include funding provided directly to faculty members (Faculty Research Incentive Awards, Grant Development Awards, Rapid Response Awards, Seminar Speaker Series Awards, Strategic Investment Program Awards) and students (Graduate Student Research Awards, Undergraduate Student Research Support, Student Travel Awards, and Summer Student Internships). Other types of funding provided to the campus may include support for workshops and short courses, the COAST Federal Work-Study Pilot Program, and travel to COAST meetings and events. Extramural funding reported was obtained in whole or in part as a result of COAST support.


